Water Works and Lighting Commission provides scholarship opportunities for individuals pursuing continued education at an accredited college or university in Wisconsin or an adjacent-state, in a related field that could lead to a career in the electric and/or water utility industry.

The Memorial Scholarship award will be for \$1,000 per year, renewable each year the recipient meets the requirements, up to 4 years. One scholarship will be available per year.

The Employee Scholarship award will be offered as a one-time \$1,000 scholarship, and will be only offered to current employees children that meet the application requirements. All scholarship recipients will be given consideration for summer employment.

Eligibility

Traditional graduating high school students who are current WW&LC customers or dependents of current WW&LC customers attending post-secondary education are eligible to apply. Children of current WW&LC employees are also eligible to apply for this scholarship, but can only receive one of the two scholarship offers.

- Attach a copy of your high school and/or college transcript.
- Attach a letter of recommendation.

Selection Procedure

The scholarship award recipient decision will be made by the Water Works and Lighting Commission. Recipients will receive their award after verification of continuing higher education.

Academic Standards

Student must be a full-time (12 credits) student and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.7 for scholarship money to be awarded and continue at an annual basis. This is dependent on the length of degree, i.e. Wisconsin or adjacent-state four-year degree at a university or college would receive four years of scholarship money, and a two-year technical degree would receive two years of scholarship money.

Scholarship recipients will be required each year to provide WW&LC with their current cumulative GPA, and documentation that they are enrolled as a full-time (12 credits) student by June 1st.
